## **1836 Distilling, LLC, announces a groundbreaking ceremony for its new home on Keuka Lake**

KEUKA LAKE, May 5 2019:

1836 Distilling announced a groundbreaking ceremony to take place for its new venture, Barrelhouse 6 Distillery, on Keuka Lake in the town of Pulteney, NY. The event will take place on May 19, 2019, at 9558 Middle Road. Proceedings will commence at 1:00 p.m.

Upon its completion, the building will contain a state-of-the-art distilling room, and will feature lake views from an outdoor patio and balcony, as well as a tasting room where visitors will sample the distillery's premium craft spirits. The new facility will create a unique and personal experience in the Finger Lakes wine country by authentically producing premium spirits while fostering a strong sense of community, land preservation, and supporting local farmers and businesses.

Barrelhouse 6 will host hands-on classes by their master distiller, bottling parties where guests will get to bottle and take home a spirit of their choice and special events featuring local, live entertainment. Guests who take classes will also get a tour of the distilling facilities including the custom-built, 500-gallon copper two-stage reflux column still from Hillbilly Stills in Tennessee.

Barrelhouse 6 will be a destination for all those who have an interest in the art of craft distilling and wish to spend time with old and new friends in the heart of New York's wine country. This spirit of welcoming and creating new friends is a key part of the distillery's mission.

Construction is expected to be completed in August of 2019, with a projected opening in September.
